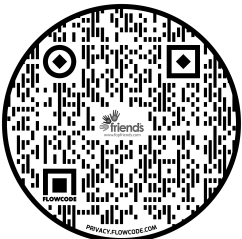
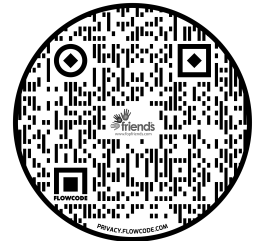
FOP Fibrodysplasia Ossificans Progressiva: the essential facts

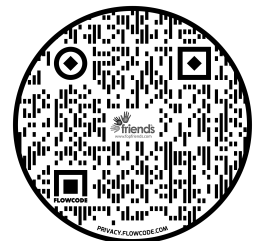
